then feed it from anywhere.

A project is a home for everything that belongs to one bigger thing. Start it by voice in a second, then drop notes, photos and files into it as they come up.

1 · Start a project


Say “Start a project called...” and name it. The words after “called” become the name.

 “Start a project called Boat Refit”

 “Start a project called Kitchen Renovation”

 “Create a project called Wedding Planning”

 “New project called Website Redesign”

 “Begin a project called Garage Clear-Out”

What happens: It creates the project, ready for you to fill. Start / create / new / begin / add / make all work.

2 · Feed the project (in the app)

Once a project exists, open it and add captures — this part is a tap, not a spoken command.

What happens: From the project screen you can attach a voice note, a photo, a link or a file, so everything about that project lives in one place.

GOOD TO KNOW

- Say the word “project” so the app knows you’re not just adding a task.
- Give it a clear, short name — you’ll be picking it from a list later.
